



Basic Pet First-Aid Kit

Meds:

- Alcohol pads
- Antihistamine
- Betadine (eliminates bacteria that might otherwise cause infection)
- Cortisone spray or cream
- Eye wash
- Hydrogen Peroxide (to induce vomiting)
- Styptic powder
- Triple antibiotic ointment

Supplies:

- Cotton balls or swabs
- Disposable gloves
- First aid tape (cloth)
- Gauze pads
- Non-stick pads
- Vet wrap (gentle) (self-adhering medical tape to keep dust/dirt out of wounds)

Gear:

- Blanket
- Blunt end scissors
- Cold and heat packs
- Ear syringe
- Emergency Information
- Eye dropper or oral syringe
- Flashlight
- Rectal Thermometer
- Slip leash
- Towel
- Tweezers (blunt)

NOTE:
